## **Dress Code**

**The student dress code at Kenilworth State Community College supports the objectives of the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 and, in particular, promotes the values of the school.**

### **School Values**

Parents enrol their students at Kenilworth State Community College with the understanding that the uniform, approved by the Parents and Citizens Association, will be worn at all times.

The wearing of the uniform:

Builds school spirit and promotes a positive image of the school in the community.

Promotes belonging, fairness and equity where students are not discriminated against because of the quality of their clothes.

Promotes the safety of all students by meeting Sun Safety and Workplace Health and Safety requirements.

Supports student participation in all activities.

### UNIFORMS

School uniform colours are green and gold. The school uniform comprises a range of garments - all designed to give wearers and their parents the opportunity to mix and match as desired. Samples of the school uniform can be found in the uniform shop and all polo shirts, skorts, shorts, hats and jumpers can be purchased through our P&C.

#### **All Students**

Green, black and gold polo style shirt with school emblem

Black tracksuit pants (for Winter).

Green Zip-up, jumper with KSCC logo (for Winter)

#### **Pants options for all Students**

Skort with KSCC embroidered on the side

Black Leggings (for Winter)

Black shorts with KSCC embroidered on the side.

#### **Hats**

The P&C supports the Sun Safe Policy. A Sunsafe hat is essential and a green hat with the KSCC logo embroidered on it is available from the Uniform Shop.

#### **Shoes and Socks**

Enclosed, black sports or dress shoes with appropriate plain white socks.

## **Jewellery**

For safety reasons, the following list constitutes the only permissible jewellery to be worn at school:

One set of earrings (small sleepers/studs)

Watch

Medical identification.

## **Hair**

Neat, traditional and contemporary hair cuts are acceptable. Extreme styles are not appropriate for school, for example, dread locks, mohawks etc. Hair longer than the shoulders must be tied up for health and safety reasons. Hair ties should be in school colours (green, gold or black).

## **Other**

Nail polish, hair colours and make-up are not acceptable at school.

## **Non Uniform Days**

The dress code on non-uniform days must comply with Sun Safety and Workplace Health and Safety requirements, namely, no singlets, no bare midriffs or muscle shirts. Appropriate shoes and a hat must be worn.
