This funding will be used to

- Increase student achievement in Reading
 - 85% of students reaching at or above Reading benchmarks for their age/year level.
 - 85% of students achieving a C or above for English for Semester 2 2017.
- Increase student achievement in NAPLAN Upper 2 Bands for Numeracy and Writing
 - 30% of Year 3 students in the Upper 2 Bands for Numeracy.
 - 35% of Year 5 students in the Upper 2 Bands for Numeracy.
 - 35% of Year 3 students in the Upper 2 Bands for Writing.
 - 30% of Year 5 students in the Upper 2 Bands for Writing.

Our initiatives include

- Purchasing significant number of new reading resources to ensure a variety of texts are available at each Reading level.
- All staff participating in coaching and feedback processes in order to improve pedagogical practices when teaching reading.
- Teachers being released as part of the coaching and feedback process for one day per term.
- Enrolling selected students in Year 3 and Year 5 to participate in the “Just Write!” and “Solve It!” online IMPACT projects in Term 1.
- Employing an additional teacher aide to support differentiation, support and extension in all classrooms.

Our school will improve student outcomes by
